

Roth Prize

The Mercersburg Society offers an annual prize of \$1000 for the best student paper pertaining to Mercersburg Theology, historical or contemporary. Undergraduate, graduate, and seminary students are welcome to submit papers written in their courses or arising from independent study. It is expected that papers will be approximately 15-20 pages in length, complete with appropriate documentation.

The Roth Prize is named in honor of Jeffrey Roth, a founding member of the Mercersburg Society. It aims to promote the study of Mercersburg Theology from a variety of angles – historical, pastoral, practical, comparative, etc.

The recipient of the prize will be invited to present the winning essay at a Mercersburg Society Convocation (held annually in June). At the decision of the editors, the paper may then be published in the *New Mercersburg Review*.
